Evaluating Your Men's Team Ministry

- 1. Remember our goal: Practice the love of Christ towards people with long term needs so our churches can say, "There is no needy person among us."
- **2.** We define the practice of the love of Christ as containing three elements:
 - a Identifying with someone
 - **b** Committing to them
 - c Sacrificing for them
- **3.** Survey your care receivers.
 - a Has your team come to know and understand you?
 - **b** Has your team demonstrated commitment by faithfully and consistently serving you?
 - c Has your team helped you meet any ongoing pressing needs in your life?
- 4. Review your church's readiness for meeting emergency and catastrophic needs.
- 5. Survey your men for feedback on your men's team ministry.
- 6. Address any practical issues and make adjustments to your men's team ministry model.
